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Forward Looking Statement

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JORC and Competent Person Statement

Information herein relating to Exploration Results, Resources and Resource Targets is based on information compiled by Ian Levy BSc, MSc, who is a Fellow of The Australasian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy and a Fellow of the Australian Institute of Geoscientists. Mr Levy is employed by ABx as Chief Executive Officer.

Mr Levy has more than five years experience relevant to the style of mineralisation and type of deposit being reported and to the activity which he is undertaking to qualify as a Competent Person as defined in the 2004 Edition of the 'Australasian Code for Reporting of Exploration Results, Minerals Resources and Ore Reserves' (the JORC Code). This report is issued with the prior written consent of the Competent Person as to the form and context in which it appears.

Exploration Target Statement

ABx has an exploration target of 200 to 300 million tonnes of bauxite, based on the Maiden Mineral Resources announced in February 2010 of 22 million tonnes of bauxite from 118 drillholes drilled across an area that is less than 10% of the known bauxite deposits on a single Exploration Lease EL 6997 at Inverell in northern NSW. In accordance with the JORC Code, readers are advised that "the potential quality and grade is conceptual in nature, that there has been insufficient exploration to define full Mineral Resources and that it is uncertain if further exploration will result in the determination of a Mineral Resource". Tenement EL 6997 was the first of 29 tenements to be drilled and ABx sees no reason to vary its exploration target.



DEMAND

 Aluminium demand is rising in emerging, modern economies - China is largest producer & consumer of aluminium but relies increasingly on imports of bauxite & alumina, mainly from Indonesia and Australia

SUPPLY


- Major aluminium companies (the "Big Al's") secured the world's major bauxite occurrences in 1960s as a barrier to entry China missed out
- China, India & Middle East need new bauxite provinces to open-up

PRICES & COMPETITION FOR AUSTRALIAN BAUXITE

- Chinese bauxite import price now sets a market price (like iron ore)
- Bauxite prices are rising but MUST RISE FURTHER to bring on new supply of bauxite and alumina
- China has strong competition from Europe, Brazil, Russia, Australia,
 India, Middle East & America to secure Australian bauxite resources.








China Bauxite Imports Growing



August 2010 Update:

- Additional 162 holes completed
- Up to 9.4 metres bauxite intercept
- Average 4.8 5.4 metres of bauxite
- Resource upgrade commenced



2010 Drilling Progressing Well

- 162 new holes at Inverell, Nth NSW resource upgrade commenced
- 18 new holes at Pindaroi nearby located up to 12 metres of bauxite
- 115 new holes at Pechey-Geham bauxite deposits in Hampton, Sth QLD intersected up to 13 metres of bauxite assays soon
- 75 new holes at Binjour, central QLD intersected up to 11 metres bauxite, assays awaited.

BINJOUR LOOKS GOOD

Discovery hole hit 9m @ 50.8% Al₂O₃ & 2.8% SiO₂

Screened at 0.26_{mm} 9m @ 53.1% Al₂O₃ & 1.3% SiO₂

- Drilling is progressing 4 months ahead of schedule 1000 holes in 2010 should be achieved. Could be 6 months ahead of schedule by year-end.
- ABZ delivered as promised in March '10 accelerated exploration





Outlook & Newsflow

- Drill a further 350 holes into known bauxite deposits on 6 tenements
- Commenced Resource Estimation in late July 2010
- Identify "promising" project areas July & August 2010
- Commence discussions with potential partners in Sept-Dec 2010 Open-door to all potential partners – large balance sheets preferred
- Advise State Governments of progress 3 state-significant projects
- Complete the 1000 holes target by mid December 2010
- Drilling Tasmanian bauxite deposits in Summer
- Further Resource Estimations commencing January 2011
